

Darling Pincushion



This is a perfect little project for your bits and pieces of yarn leftover from bigger projects. It's a small pincushion that will keep your darning needle safe.

Stitches used in this pattern:

Chain - ch Slip stitch - sl st Single crochet - sc Double crochet - dc

Lets get started!

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First make a cute flower, I made the <u>picot flower</u> from <u>SkaMama.com</u> with the yarn Scheepjes Secret Garden and hook 4.0 mm.

Leave a long tail to use for sewing later.



Make the bottom:

Row 1: Ch 3, make 11 dc's in 1:st ch, sl st in 3:rd ch.

Row 2: ch 2, dc in the same stitch. 2 dc in each dc. Sl st in 2.nd ch.

I used the yarn Scheepjes Catona, **two strands** and hook 5.0 mm.





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Make the top side:

Row 1: Ch 3, make 11 dc's in 1:st ch, sl st in 3:rd ch.

Row 2: ch 2, dc in the same stitch. 2 dc in each dc. Sl st in 2.nd ch.

Row 3: ch 1, 1 sc in each dc. S1 st in 1:st ch. (this row gives the top a curved shape)

I used the yarn Scheepjes Catona, two strands and hook 5.0 mm.



Sew the flower on the top side using the yarn tail and a darning needle.





Crochet the bottom and top side together with slip stitches as the pictures show, and make sure that all the ends is hidden inside. Put filling in before making the last stitches.

I used the yarn Scheepjes Secret Garden and hook 4,5 mm.





Fasten your end and you're all done!
