

Cirrus

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Abbreviations:

Sl st - slip stitch

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Dc - double crochet

2 dc tog - 2 double crochet together

Picot = 3 ch, 1 sc in 1:st ch.

This shawl has the shape of a “shallow” triangle and is worked from side to side. During the first half you make increases and during the second half you make decreases to get the triangular shape. You can decide how long/big you want your shawl by the numbers you repeat row 7-12. When you make the second half of the shawl you repeat row A-F the same number of times as row 7-12. First you crochet the body of the shawl as shown in diagram 1 and then you crochet the border as shown in diagram 2.
