

Mijo Granny Join

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This granny join suits grannysquares with 2 chains in each corner and 1 chain between the 3-dc-groups. This join is made of 2 rows, the first row is a "granny row" in the same colour as the actual join and the second row is the row where you join the squares. You can skip the first row if you like a thinner join.

For my squares I have used a mix of <u>Scheepjes Catona</u>, <u>Scheepjes Sunkissed</u> and <u>Scheepjes Cotton 8</u>. The Catona yarn is a little bit thicker than the others but I think it blends well. Hook 3.5 mm. All these 100% cotton yarns can be found at <u>Favoritgarner</u>. I used Cotton 8, colour 501, for my join.

Stitches used in this pattern (US terms):

Sl st - slip stitch Ch - chain Dc - double crochet

There are two videos of this join on my <u>FB-sid</u>e.

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First square:

Row 1:

Connect your yarn with a sl st in any corner. 4 ch (= 1 dc + 2 ch), 3 dc in the same 2-ch-space.

(1 ch, 3 dc in next 1-ch-space) until last 1-ch-space of the side. 1 ch, 3 dc + 2 ch + 3 dc in the 2-ch-space of next corner. Repeat *-* 3 times.

(1 ch, 3 dc in next 1-ch-space) until last 1-ch-space of the side. 1 ch, 2 dc in the 2-ch-space of next corner. Sl st in 2:nd ch of the row.



Row 2:

Sl st to next corner, 3 ch (= 1 dc + 1 ch). 1 dc + 2 ch + 1 dc + 1 ch + 1 dc in the same 2-ch-space.

1 ch, skip 2 dc, 1 dc in next dc. 1 ch, 1 dc in next dc. (1 ch, skip 1 dc, 1 dc in next dc. 1 ch, 1 dc in next dc) until 3:rd last dc on the side. 1 ch, 1 dc + 1 ch + 1 dc + 2 ch + 1 dc + 1 ch in the 2-ch-space of the next corner. Repeat *-* 3 times.

1 ch, skip 2 dc, 1 dc in next dc. 1 ch, 1 dc in next dc. (1 ch, skip 1 dc, 1 dc in next dc. 1 ch, 1 dc in next dc) until 3:rd last dc on the side. 1 ch, sl st in 2:nd ch of the row.



Square 2:

Row 1: as square 1.

Row 2:

Crochet row 2 as on square 1 but when you get to the second corner you make 1 dc + 1 ch + 1 dc + 1 ch. 1 sl st in 1:st ch of previous squares corner.





You will now continue to join the squares in every dc as follows:

When you have made 1 dc drop the loop and insert the hook in the correspondent dc on previous square. Pick up the loop and pull through the dc. 1 ch.

Continue like this and when you reach next corner you make a sl st in the 1:st ch of the previous squares corner and then 1 ch + 1 dc + 1 dc in the 2-ch-space of the corner and finish the row as on square 1.







Square 3:

Crochet as square 2.

Square 4:

When you get to the corner you make 1 sl st in the free ch in the corner of the square to the right (square 2) of the square you are joining. Then you make a sl st in the free ch in the corner of the square (square 3) to the left of the square you are joining. Continue as before.
