

Frozen Bud Beanie

Design by Johanna Lindahl / Mijo Crochet

Yarn:

Two skeins of <u>Pingouin Pingo Pepite 100 g</u> from <u>Favoritgarner</u>. For the beanie in the picture I used the colours gris and touareg. This design is worked with two strands of yarn so you can make the beanie solid or mixed coloured.

Hook: 6.0 mm.



Abbreviations: (US terms)

Ch - chain
Sl st - slip stitch
Dc - double crochet
Hdc - half double crochet
Fpdc - front post double crochet
fpdc 2 tog - 2 front post double crochet together

Tips:

- Ch 1 in the beginning of a row counts as 1 hdc if nothing else is indicated.
- Stitches between () are repeated as many times as indicated after the parenthesis.
- Stitches between { } are made in the same stitch.
- Stitches between | | shows how many stitches you should have after the row is done.

Note! This beanie is crocheted with two strands of yarn.

Row 1:

Ch 2 (does not count) and 10 dc in a magic circle. Sl st in the 1:st dc.

[10 dc]

Row 2:

Ch 1, 1 fpdc in the same dc. ({1 hdc + 1 fpdc} in next dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

|10 fpdc and 10 hdc|

Row 3:

Ch 1, 1 hdc in the same hdc, 1 fpdc in next dc. (2 hdc in next hdc, 1 fpdc in next dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

10 fpdc and 20 hdc

Row 4:

Ch 1, 1 hdc in next hdc, 2 fpdc in next dc. (1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 fpdc in next dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

[20 fpdc and 20 hdc]

Row 5:

Ch 1, 1 hdc in next hdc. 1 fpdc in next dc, 1 dc **between** the two dc's, 1 fpdc in next dc. (1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 1 fpdc in next dc, 1 dc **between** the two dc's, 1 fpdc in next dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

|20 fpdc, 10 dc and 20 hdc|

Row 6:

Ch 1, 1 hdc in next hdc. 1 fpdc in next 3 dc. (1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 1 fpdc in next 3 dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

30 fpdc and 20 hdc



Row 7:

Ch 1, 1 hdc in next hdc. 1 fpdc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 fpdc in next dc. (1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 1 fpdc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 fpdc in next dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

|20 fpdc, 20 dc and 20 hdc|

Row 8-17:

Ch 1, 1 hdc in next hdc. 1 fpdc in next 4 dc. (1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 1 fpdc in next 4 dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st ch.

|40 fpdc and 20 hdc|

You can skip or add rows here if you like a longer or shorter beanie.

Row 18:

Ch 1 (does not count). (Fpdc 2 tog in next 2 hdc, 1 fpdc in next 4 dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st fpdc 2 tog.

40 fpdc and 10 fpdc 2 tog

Row 19:

Ch 1 (does not count), 1 fpdc in the same fpdc 2 tog, 1 fpdc in next 4 dc. (1 fpdc in next fpdc 2 tog, 1 fpdc in next 4 dc) until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st fpdc.

|50 fpdc|

Row 20 - 21:

Ch 1 (does not count), 1 fpdc in each dc until the last dc of the row. Sl st in the 1:st fpdc.

|50 fpdc|

Row 22:

1 slip stitch in the back loop only in each dc of the row. Mind your tension since slip stitches are not very elastic. Use one size bigger hook if you need.

Weave in your ends and your Frozen Bud is finished!
