

Petal Coasters

Yarn suggestions:

I recommend a cotton yarn for this pattern that is suitable for hook 3.0 - 3.5 mm (fingering). The coaster in the pictures is made with Scheepjes Catona color 179, 385 and 393.

Hook: 3.0 - 3.5 mm.

Size: 10 - 11 cm in diameter depending on yarn and hook size.



Abbreviations (US terms):

Ch - chain
Sl st - slip stitch
Sc - single crochet
Dc - double crochet
Dc2tog - double crochet 2 stitches together
Dc3tog - double crochet 3 stitches together
Inv join - Invisible join *
Sp - space

Stitches marked with a * are described on my blog, mijocrochet.se.

Tips:

- Ch 2 in the beginning of a row counts as 1 double crochet.
- Ch 1 in the beginning of a row counts as 1 single crochet.
- Stitches between [] are repeated as many times as indicated after the square brackets.
- Stitches between { } are made in the same stitch or chain space.
- Stitches between | | shows how many stitches you should have after completing the row.

Pattern:

Start:

Ch 4, sl st in the 1st chain to form a ring.

Row 1:

Ch 1, 9 sc in the ch ring. Sl st in the 1st sc in the beginning of the row.

|10 sc|







Row 2:

Ch 2, dc2tog in the same sc (= dc3tog).

[Ch 2, dc3tog in next sc] 9 times.

Ch 2, sl st in the 1st dc3tog in the beginning of the row. Cut yarn if you are changing color.

|10 dc3tog and 10 ch-2 sp|





Row3:

Join your new color with a sl st in any ch-2 sp, or: if you use the same color make a sl st in next ch-2 sp.

Ch 2, dc2tog in the same ch-2 sp (= dc3tog). Ch 1, dc3tog in the same ch-2 sp.

[Ch 1, $\{dc3tog + ch 1 + dc3tog\}$ in next ch-2 sp] 9 times.

Ch 1, sl st in the 1st dc3tog in the beginning of the row. Cut yarn if you are changing color.

|20 dc3tog and 20 ch-1 sp|

Row 4:

Join your new color with a sl st in any ch-1 sp, or: if you are using the same color make a sl st in next ch-1 sp.

Ch 2, dc2tog in the same ch-1 space (= dc3tog). [Ch 2, dc3tog in next ch-1 sp] 19 times. Ch 2, sl st in the 1st dc3tog in the beginning of the row. Cut yarn if you are changing color.

|20 dc3tog and 20 ch-2 sp|



Row 5:

Join your new color with a sl st in any ch-2 sp, or: if you are using the same color make a sl st in next ch-2 sp.

Ch 2, 6 dc in the same ch-2 sp.

[Ch 1, skip 1 ch-2 sp, 7 dc in next ch-2 sp] 9 times. Ch 1, sl st in the 2nd ch in the beginning of the row. Cut yarn.

|70 dc and 10 ch-1 sp|

Row 6:

Mind your tension when crocheting slip stitches so that your work don't curl. If you need, use one size bigger hook for this row.

Join your new color, or the same color, with a sl st in the 3rd dc of any 7-dc group. Sl st in next 4 dc.

[1 sc around both ch sp of row 4 and 5, sl st in next 7 dc] 9 times. Sl st in next 2 dc, finish of with inv join.

|70 sl st and 10 sc|
