

# Lil' Xmas Tree

Design by Johanna Lindahl / Mijo Crochet

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Yarn: <u>Scheepjes Catona 10 g</u> one skein of each color 515, 106 and 507. One skein of color 515 (green) is enough for 4–5 trees.

Hook: 3,0 mm

Size: Approx 8 cm high (string and pearl excluded) and 6.5 cm wide.

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## Abbreviations (US terms):

CH – chain

Sl st – slip stitch

Sc – single crochet

Dc – double crochet

The tree: (color 515)

#### Row 1:

Save a long end to use as a loop for the decoration.

Ch 4, 2 dc in the 4th ch from your hook. Turn.

|3 dc|



#### Row 2:

Ch 3 (= 1 dc), 1 dc in the same dc. 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in the  $3^{rd}$  ch in the beginning of previous row. Turn.

|5 dc|



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#### Row 3:

Ch 3 (= 1 dc), 1 dc in the same dc. 1 dc in next 3 dc. 2 dc in the  $3^{rd}$  ch in the beginning of previous row. Turn.

|7 dc|



#### Row 4-7:

Ch 3 (= 1 dc), 1 dc in the same dc. (1 dc in next dc) until the second last dc. 2 dc in the  $3^{rd}$  ch in the beginning of previous row. Turn.

When row 7 is made cut your yarn and fasten the end but let the end in the top of the tree be.

|Row 4 - 9 dc, row 5 - 11 dc, row 6 - 13 dc, row 7 - 15 dc|






### The garland: (color 106)


Save a long end to use as a loop for the decoration.

The garland is made with sl st on the right side of the tree. It is important that you keep the yarn at the back of your work at all times.

Join your yarn with a sl st in the very 1st ch at the top of the tree. Ch 2.



Sl st around the outermost dc on row 2.





Sl st around the remaining dc's on row 2. Ch 2.



Sl st around the outermost dc on row 3. Sl st around the remaining dc's on row 3. Ch 2.



Continue in the same way over row 4-7. cut your yarn and fasten the end but let the end in the top of the tree be.



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The stem: (color 507)

#### Row 1:

Join your yarn with a sl st in the back loop only in the  $7^{th}$  dc on row 7. 1 sc in the back loop only in next 2 dc. Turn.



Row 2:

Ch 1, 1 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next ch. Cut yarn and fasten both ends.







Now tie the ends at the top and form a loop to hang your tree. You can add a pearl before you tie if you like.
