


Petite Star

(English US terms)

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Materials:

• Yarn:

Scheepjes Catona 10~g/25~g/50~g~(100% Mercerised Cotton). Colors showing in the pictures: 251, 390 and 517.







Or:

Scheepjes Catona Shine 50g (98% Mercerised Cotton / 2% Metallic Polyester). Colors showing in the pictures: 383-G, 525-R and 527-S.







It takes just under two grams of yarn per star.

- Crochet hook: 3.0 mm.
- Darning needle
- Scissors

Size:

If you use the same yarn and hook as suggested in the pattern the star's diameter is approx. 6cm.












Abbreviations **US** terms:

St – stitch

Ch – chain
Ss – slip stitch
Sc – single crochet
Hdc – half double crochet
Dc – Double crochet

Beg - Beginning



	Description
0	Chain (ch)
•	Slip stitch (ss)
X	Single crochet (sc)
+	Half double crochet (hdc)
Ŧ	Double crochet (dc)

Pattern notes:


- This pattern is worked in rounds.
- Stitches between { } are made in the same ch-sp.
- Stitches between () are repeated as many times as indicated after the parentheses.
- Stitches between | | shows how many stitches you should have after completing the round.



Pattern:

Start:

Ch5, ss in the first ch to make a circle.




Round 1:

Ch1 (does not count as a stitch),

12sc in the ch-ring just made, ss in the first sc at the beg of the round.

|12 sc|








Round 2:

Ch3 (counts as 1 dc), 1dc into st at base of ch,

(ch2, skip 1 sc, 2dc in next sc) 5 times, ch2, ss in the third ch at the beg of the round.

|12 dc, 6 ch-2 sps|






Round 3:

Note: The last ss in this row will be crocheted over the first ss.

Ss in the space before next dc,

(ch1, {1hdc, 2dc, ch2, 2dc, 1hdc} in next ch-2 sp, ch1, ss **between** next 2 dc) 6 times, cut yarn.

|6 ss, 12 hdc, 24 dc, 6 ch-2 sps, 12 ch-1 sps|





Fasten ends, block your star(s) and attach a string for hanging. I used jute string for a more rustic feel.
